Module One

"A Historical Approach to Understanding the Bible"

October 28, November 4, 11 and 18
Wednesday evenings 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm

Have you ever wanted to understand the Bible better? Have you ever found yourself struggling to read the Bible in a meaningful way? Why did certain books make it into the canon and others did not? Want to know what "canon" means? Come and join us and find out. These four sessions will look at the Bible from a historical perspective in terms of its construction and its value to the communities of faith to whom it was directed. These sessions will serve as a great way to get an overview of the Bible.

"A Historical Look at the Birth Narratives"

What do Mark and John have to say? For three weeks during the Advent season we will be looking at these cherished stories and re-discovering the "truth" and meaning within them.

"Countering Pharaoh's Production-Consumption Society Today"

This five-week study series will challenge us to look at how we "choose" to live our lives. This study draws upon the Torah (a.k.a. Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy) and the message of Jesus.
